

- Ultimate goal to promote one single global 6G standard






Global Dialogues

- Promote the adoption of a single global 6G standard










Placing SNS at a global Roadmap


SNS Message fine-tuning & dissemination to the world

 - Analysis of interests, priorities and synergies with other global regions, elaboration of SNS R&I WPs
 - Participation in panel discussions of R&D funding agencies (IEEE ICASSP) on 6G: NSF, UKRI, DEVCOM, DOST (India), MIST (Israel)









- SNS ICE led the effort to create a "common EU front" for the 3GPP SA1 WS in May 2024
- **Organized the entire** process, and engaged the active SNS projects & several EU National **Initiatives**
- Final goal achieved with common input presented at the SA1 WS from **EU/SNS**
- **Assisting the maximization** of the SNS community
 - Strong links with SDOs (3GPP SA1, ETSI Board, pre-Standards WG)
