

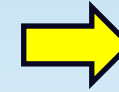

- “...The applicants should select their targeted vertical sectors according to the project objectives and use-cases, considering the vertical priorities for (1) Industry/Manufacturing (including robotics), (2) Media (including gaming, broadcasting...), (3) Transportation/Logistics, (4) Emergency and Safety Services and (5) Health (indicative order not prioritized). The afore verticals to be considered should be in line with the European view on 6G use-cases that were presented during the 3GPP SA1 Workshop in May 2024. The projects are expected to focus on specific verticals sectors (one or maximum two verticals per project, in the case of existing commonalities/complementarities between the selected two verticals; nevertheless, if addressing two verticals, applicants should still clearly indicate the centre of gravity, i.e. the main vertical of the project, for evaluation purposes)...”
- “...Note: To ensure a balanced portfolio within Stream D and to guarantee that the approved projects will have different centres of gravity from the above 5 vertical priorities, grants will be awarded to applications not only in order of ranking but at least also to one project that is the highest ranked within each of the above vertical priorities, provided that the applications attain all thresholds (and subject to available budget). Only the centre of gravity vertical area will be considered in terms of topic coverage during the evaluation process”
